



Introduction

This manual describes the RWB-2D, RWB-2S, and RWB-1TD Heavy Duty Workbenches. More information about the full line of Ranger Products is available at **rangerproducts.com**.

This manual is mandatory reading for all users of these Heavy duty Workbenches, including anyone who assembles, operates, maintains, or repairs them.

DANGER Be very careful when setting up, using, maintaining, or repairing this heavy duty work bench; failure to do so could result in property damage, product damage, injury, or (in very rare cases) death. Do not make modifications to the unit; this voids the warranty and increases the chances of injury or property damage. Make sure to read and follow the instructions on the labels on the unit.

Keep this manual on or near the Heavy Duty Workbench so that anyone who uses or services it can read it.

Technical support for your Heavy Duty Workbench is available from your distributor or directly from BendPak Ranger: using a web browser, visit the **BendPak Support website**.

Shipping Information

Your Heavy Duty Workbench was carefully checked before shipping. Nevertheless, you should thoroughly inspect the shipment **before** you sign to acknowledge that you received it.

When you sign the bill of lading, it tells the carrier that the items on the invoice were received in good condition. *Do not sign the bill of lading until after you have inspected the shipment.* If any of the items listed on the bill of lading are missing or damaged, do not accept the shipment until the carrier makes a notation on the bill of lading that lists the missing or damaged goods.







Assembly

NOTICE

- 1. Place workbench top (#2) upside down on a smooth surface
- 2. Attach the four legs (#4) to workbench top (#2) by bolts with washers (#1), then finger tighten
- 3 Attach the shelf (#5) to the legs (#4) by bolts with washers (#1), then finger tighten

If your Heavy Duty Workbench is a RWB-1TD – One Drawer, Fluid Catch model, please complete the assembly of your Heavy Duty Workbench using the 3a step listed below; if yours is not this model, please skip this step.

3a Insert casters (#11) to all four legs.

4. Set the workbench upright, check that worktop is level, then tighten all the hardware with a wrench.

NOTICE If your Heavy Duty Workbench is a RWB-2D – Two Drawer model, please complete the assembly of your Heavy Duty Workbench using the two steps listed below.

5. If the drawers are not installed, push on the black plastic levers on the sides of the drawer. Left side of drawer lever pressed up. Slide into drawer slot on (#1) workbench top.

6. Check if the keys work properly. Each drawer has its own two keys. If you require further assistance, please contact BendPak Ranger Service for information (please have the model and serial number of your unit available) at **(805) 933-9970** follow the prompts to reach the Service Department.

NOTICE If your Heavy Duty Workbench is a RWB-1TD– One Drawer, One Fluid Catch model, please complete the assembly of your Heavy Duty Workbench using the last step listed below.

7. Install Plastic Oil Receiver Tray (#10) on the left side of (#2) workbench top.
